Re: Testing of Invisible Gloves against SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19)

I wish to inform you that the Invisible Gloves (IG) topical cream has recently been tested at UBC's Level-3 Laboratory by our faculty member from the Division of Infectious Diseases. The testing is to assess the antiviral property of IG cream against SARS-CoV-2 in suspension. The final results confirmed that a contact time of five minutes is effective in eliminating SARS-CoV-2 with no cytotoxicity. A formal detailed report will follow after further testing for shorter contact times is completed.
